Junior Year -- Spring Term

Week 2 Application to the Comparative Literature Honors Track

Deadline: Friday, Week 2, Spring term

Submit to Director of Undergraduate Studies (cc to Undergraduate Coordinator) via

email: transcript, writing sample, name of faculty who has agreed to provide

recommendation.

Week 4 Student will be notified of application result.

Week 8 After acceptance into the Honors Track, approach potential advisor (primary reader) for

the Honors Thesis. When advisor agrees, request that advisor send notification of agreement to **Director of Undergraduate Studies (cc to Undergraduate Coordinator)**.

Senior Year -- Fall Term

ASAP Check in with thesis adviser.

Week 5 <u>Submit thesis topic</u> (after consulting with thesis adviser) via email to **Director of**

Undergraduate Studies (cc to Undergraduate Coordinator).

Week 8 Submit thesis proposal (after consulting with thesis adviser on preferred way to write this)

via email to Director of Undergraduate Studies (cc to Undergraduate Coordinator)

Week 10 Register for COLT 403 Winter term (4 credits of independent study). Submit signed

authorization form to **Undergraduate Coordinator**. Upon approval, student will be authorized to register. Registration in DuckWeb involves 2 steps: initial registration, then

changing the number of credits from the default 1 credit to 4 credits.

Senior Year -- Winter Term

By Week 1 Meet with adviser to schedule COLT 403 meetings for the term.

Throughout Meet regularly with thesis adviser.

By Week 5 Choose secondary reader with help of thesis adviser and/or Director of Undergraduate

Studies. Report name of secondary reader via email to **Director of Undergraduate Studies** (cc to **Undergraduate Coordinator**); meet with that reader at least once before the end of

Winter term.

By end Full draft of Honors Thesis due (40-60 pages with a sustained argument): e-mail document

to Director of Undergraduate Studies (cc to Undergraduate Coordinator), copying your

adviser.

Senior Year -- Spring Term

By end Final version of Honors Thesis due. **Submit document, signed by adviser and secondary**Week 5 **reader, to Director of Undergraduate Studies and Undergraduate Coordinator.**

Week 6 <u>Schedule thesis defense</u> with adviser and secondary reader; inform department of

date/time/place (typically COLT 312). Check with Undergraduate Coordinator to arrange

location.

Week 7 Prepare thesis defense

Week 8 <u>Thesis defense</u>

By end Final copy of thesis due to Director of Undergraduate Studies and Undergraduate

Week 10 **Coordinator** (submit via email).
